Ione PD Code Enforcement

Beginning May 2018, the Ione PD will begin enforcing municipal code violations. Some of the immediate concerns will be:

Abandoned and/or Wrecked Vehicles

Vehicles that are abandoned or inoperable that are parked on private or public property are violations. These must be moved to an enclosed garage or behind a solid wood or masonry fence where they are out of public view.

Trailers and Mobile Homes

These vehicles may be parked for no more than 48 hours on a public street. RV and camp trailers may not be used as living quarters, even if the vehicle is parked on private property.

Trash and Rubbish

This section includes organic and inorganic waste, trash, tires, etc. All items must be in enclosed containers. Items stored in a manner that attracts pests and/or rodents, or constitutes a nuisance are considered violations of this code.

Dog Leash Law

All dogs in public must be on a leash no longer than 6', unless they are in the dog park located in Howard Park.

Persons found in violation of the provisions of the Ione Municipal Code may be subject to fines or abatement. The Ione Municipal Code is available at Ione City Hall, online at ione-ca.com/city-government/municipal-code.
